# CRITERIA FOR DECLARING A LANGUAGE AS 'CLASSICAL'

The recognition of a classical language is based on criteria established by a **Linguistic Experts Committee.** They are:

- High antiquity of its early texts/recorded history over a period of 1500-2000 Years
- A body of ancient literature/texts, which is considered a heritage by generations of speakers
- **Knowledge texts** include prose, poetry, and epic; political or **inscriptional** evidence.
