

Schedule of INDIAN CONSTITUTION

Inspired by the Government of India Act of 1935.

Originally the Constitution contained 8 schedules. 4 schedules were added subsequently.

FIRST

ARTICLES: 1 AND 4

Names of States and Union Territories with their territorial extent

THIRD

ARTICLES: 75, 99, 124, 148, 164, 188 AND 219

Form of Oath for office, Secrecy and Affirmation of:

- Union and State Ministers
- Election Candidates
- MPs and MLAs
- Judges (SC & HCs)
- Comptroller and Auditor of India (CAG)

SECOND

ARTICLES: 59, 65, 75, 97, 125, 148, 158, 164, 186 & 221

Provisions for emoluments, allowances, and privileges of:

- President and Governors
- Speaker & Deputy Speaker (LS & State Assemblies)
- Chairman & Deputy Chairman (RS & Legislative Councils)
- Judges (SC & HCs)
- CAG

FOURTH

ARTICLES: 4 AND 80

- Allocation of seats in Rajya Sabha to states & UTs

FIFTH

ARTICLE: 244

- Administration & control of scheduled areas and scheduled tribes.

SIXTH

ARTICLES: 244 AND 275

- Administration of tribal areas in the states of Assam, Meghalaya, Tripura and Mizoram.

SEVENTH

ARTICLE 246

Division of powers between Union and States in terms of:

- List I (Union) - 100 subjects
- List II (State) - 61 subjects
- List III (Concurrent) - 52 subjects

EIGHTH

ARTICLES: 344 AND 351

- Languages recognized by the Constitution (Originally 14, currently 22)

NINTH

(1st AMENDMENT ACT, 1951)

ARTICLE: 31B

- Acts and regulations for land reforms, zamindari abolition, and other matters by state legislatures and Parliament.

TENTH

(52nd AMENDMENT ACT, 1985)

ARTICLES: 102 AND 191

- Provisions for disqualification of MPs and MLAs on grounds of defection.

ELEVENTH

(73rd AMENDMENT ACT, 1992)

ARTICLE: 243G

- Specifies the powers, authority of Panchayats.

TWELFTH

(74th AMENDMENT ACT, 1992)

ARTICLE: 243W

- Specifies the powers, authority & responsibilities of Municipalities.
